Complete the online video course "ASM": [Adult Sexual Misconduct Prevention online course](#) (required only once)—excel spreadsheet provided to schools weekly;
Read the Volunteer Policy. 5630 (Volunteers): [Policy 5630](#) (annually).

Seattle Public Schools is hosting five community meetings to share information about our upcoming Operations Levy and our Buildings, Technology, Academics/Athletics IV (BTA IV) Capital Levy which will be submitted to Seattle voters in February 2016. The Operations Levy renews every three years, represents about 25% of the District's annual general fund budget and supports basic educational programs not fully funded by the state.

levy-funded construction result in a need to adjust school attendance area boundaries. [Boundary changes being implemented next year](#) are all in West Seattle near Arbor Heights Elementary, which will open in a new building in Fall 2016. Boundary and geo-zone changes for the other schools opening in 2016 have already been adjusted.

Additionally, the district is proposing minor revisions to the Student Assignment Plan to streamline and clarify questions that have been raised over the past several years. Revisions include elimination of the distance tiebreaker and other conflicting statements. Once adopted, this will be the final implementation of the [Student Assignment Plan](#).
